

Zion Lutheran Church's Postsecondary Scholarship Fund

In accordance with Bylaw B12.04.b2.5, "Zion Lutheran Church shall have a postsecondary scholarship and fund which shall operate under guidelines found in CR12.04.b2.10. The scholarship fund shall be a ministry of the church."

The scholarship fund will function to fund scholarships in the following names:

- "The Laretta M. Raithel Scholarship" hereafter referred to as the "Raithel Scholarship."
- "The Rev. Donald F. Alber Scholarship" hereafter referred to as the "Alber Scholarship."

Monetary Management of the Fund

The monetary funds of the postsecondary scholarship fund shall managed by the Church's Endowment Committee (see CR12.04.b2.9 Part III).

Selection and Distribution of Awards

The selection and distribution of awards shall comply with the Last Will and Testament of Laretta M. Raithel, and Gift Annuity Agreement between Donald F. Alber and Wittenberg University, as best as Zion Lutheran Church is able as described below.

The selection and distribution of awards shall be made by a selection committee comprised of the Pastor(s), President of Congregation Council, and the chairs of the Study Table and Give Table, with the advice of the Treasurer and chair of the Endowment Committee.

A completed application by the applicant is required for scholarship consideration. The selection committee may consider membership, service, and participation in church activity, academic achievement, and financial need.
